ORDER ADOPTING BAIL SCHEDULE

Pursuant to Penal Code § 1269b(c), the judges of the above-entitled Court having conducted their annual review of the Inyo County Bail Schedule, and good cause appearing therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the countywide Bail Schedule set forth herein is hereby adopted, and the same shall become fully effective and implemented at 12:01 a.m. on January 1, 2013.

This Order shall supersede all prior orders, and the bail schedule set forth herein shall supersede the current and all prior bail schedules adopted in Inyo County.

The Court adopts and incorporates herein by reference the revised "2013 Uniform Bail and Penalty Schedules," adopted by

1 the Judicial Council of California in December, 2012, which
2 becomes effective January 1, 2013(California Rules of Court,
3 rule 4.102), for Traffic, Boating, Forestry, Fish and Game,
4 Public Utilities, Parks and Recreation, and Business Licensing;
5 and, as may be amended, modified, or adopted by the Judicial
6 Council in the future.

7 The bail schedule set forth herein below shall apply to any
8 individual or defendant arrested without a warrant for a
9 bailable misdemeanor or felony offense.

10 Except as expressly provided herein, bail for all
11 MISDEMEANOR offenses, not included in the aforesaid Uniform Bail
12 Schedule, shall be set at Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000). Bail
13 shall be set as follows for the following specified misdemeanor
14 offenses:

15 CVC § 23152(a) and/or (b) with two prior convictions [of
16 CVC §§ 23152, 23153, 23103 as specified in § 23103.5, PC §§
17 191.5 or 192(c)(3)] occurring within ten (10) years
(offense date to offense date) \$25,000

18 PC § 166(a)(4) \$10,000
19 When based upon an alleged violation of an "Emergency
20 Protective Order" issued pursuant to Family Code §§
6250 et seq.

21 PC § 166(c) \$10,000

22 PC § 243(e)(1) \$10,000

23 PC § 273.6 \$10,000

24 PC § 273.65 \$10,000

25
26 PC § 647(f) where the current arrest constitutes the
27 third (or more) arrest within Inyo County within thirty (30)
days immediately preceding the current arrest. \$10,000

3 Bail on FELONY offenses shall be set as follows:

4 Except as expressly provided herein, bail shall be set for
5 felonies punishable by a maximum term up to and including 36
6 months in state prison at Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000).

7 Exceptions:

- 8
- 9 • Bail shall be set in the sum of Twenty Thousand
10 Dollars (\$20,000) for a felony violation of Vehicle
Code § 2800.2(a).
 - 11 • Bail shall be set in the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars
12 (\$50,000) for a felony violation of CVC § 23153(a)
and/or (b).
 - 13 • Bail shall be set in the sum of One Hundred Thousand
14 Dollars (\$100,000) for a felony violation of CVC §
23153(a) and/or (b) or CVC § 23152(a) or (b) with one
15 or more prior felony convictions occurring within ten
(10) years [offense date to offense date] of CVC §§
16 23152(a) or (b) [punished under CVC § 23550 or former
CVC § 23175.5]; CVC § 23153(a) or (b); PC § 192(c)(1);
17 PC § 191.5; or PC § 192(c)(3).
 - 18 • Bail shall be set in the sum of One Hundred Thousand
19 Dollars (\$100,000) for a felony violation of CVC §
20 23152(a) and/or (b) with three or more prior
misdemeanor convictions of CVC §§ 23152, 23153, 23103
21 specified in § 23103.5, PC §§ 191.5 or 192(c)(3),
occurring within ten (10) years [offense date to
offense date].

22 Except as expressly provided herein, for felonies
23 punishable by a maximum term in state prison in excess of 36
24 months, up to and including 48 months, bail shall be set at
25 Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000).

26 Except as expressly provided herein, for felonies
27 punishable by a maximum term in state prison in excess of 48
28 months, up to and including 60 months, bail shall be set in the

1 sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000).

2 Exception: Bail for a felony violation of Vehicle Code §
3 2800.3 shall be set in the sum of One Hundred Thousand
4 Dollars (\$100,000).
5

6 Except as expressly provided herein, for felonies
7 punishable by a maximum term in state prison in excess of 60
8 months, and up to and including 72 months, bail shall be set in
9 the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000).

10 Except as expressly provided herein, for felonies
11 punishable by a maximum term in state prison in excess of 72
12 months, bail shall be set at Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand
13 Dollars (\$250,000).

14 The following felonies shall have bail specifically set as
15 follows:

- 16 • Stalking under any subdivision of PC § 646.9 in the
17 sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000).
- 18 • Attempted Murder shall be set at Five Hundred Thousand
19 Dollars (\$500,000).
- 20 • Murder - PC § 187 in the sum of One Million Dollars
21 (\$1,000,000).
- 22 • Capital Offenses - Unless deemed a nonbailable offense
as provided by Penal Code § 1270.5 or Article I,
Section 12 of the *California Constitution*, murder with
one or more allegations of special circumstances, or
any other offense punishable by death, in the sum of
Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000).

23 Bail shall be set in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars
24 (\$5,000) for an alleged VIOLATION OF MISDEMEANOR PROBATION,
25 whether formal or informal, which has been granted by the
26 Superior Court of California, County of Inyo (or any formerly
27 titled Court of Inyo County, California). This order supersedes
28 any previous policy concerning cite and release procedures

1 involving informal or court probationers.


2 Bail shall be set for a VIOLATION OF FELONY PROBATION
3 granted by the Superior Court of California, County of Inyo, in
4 the amount set forth herein for the offense for which the
5 probationer was convicted and placed on said probation.

6 Said bail for violation of misdemeanor or felony probation
7 granted by a Court of Inyo County, shall be in addition to any
8 bail set for any new misdemeanor or felony arrest, if any.


9 Nothing herein shall preclude application for an increase
10 in bail as provided by the provisions of PC § 1269c, or for a no
11 bail hold as provided by PC § 1270.5 and/or Article I, Section
12 12 of the *California Constitution*.

13 This Order and Bail Schedule shall remain in full force and
14 effect, until modified by further Order of the Court.
