UNIFORM FELONY BAIL SCHEDULE FOR COUNTY OF MADERA

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1269b of the California Penal Code, the following uniform County wide Schedule of Bail for all bailable felony offenses is hereby adopted by the judges of the Superior Court of the County of Madera. This Schedule sets the bail for the release of prisoners arrested (without a warrant) on felony charges for the alleged commission of any bailable offense.

This Schedule is effective JANUARY 3, 2012

If a prisoner has been arrested on more than one felony charge, or on a felony and misdemeanor charge, the highest felony bail shall be used.

The following felony offenses are not bailable IF SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES ARE PRESENT

MURDER, Penal Code §187. (Punishable by death, Penal Code §190.2). KIDNAPING, Penal Code §209 (With death of victim). TRAIN DERAILING OR WRECKING, Penal Code §219 (With death).

For all felonies wherein there are separate Victims or the same victim on separate occasions

Consecutive Bail

Where separate sex acts are committed on same Victim, each may be punishable separately

The bail for all misdemeanors not included in the "Uniform Felony Bail Schedule for the County of Madera" and/or "Uniform Bail and Penalty Schedule" issued by the Judicial Council pursuant to California rules of Court Rule 4.102 shall be the amount of \$1000.00.

CONSTITUTIONAL PROVISIONS RE ADMISSION TO BAIL

Cal. Constitution Art 1 § 12. Bail; Release on own recognizance

A person shall be released on bail by sufficient sureties, except for:

- (a) Capital crimes when the facts are evidence or the presumption great;
- (b) Felony offenses involving acts of violence on another person, or felony sexual assault offenses on another person, when the facts are evident or the presumption great and the court finds based upon clear and convincing evidence that there is a substantial likelihood the person's release would result in great bodily harm to others; or
- (c) Felony offenses when the facts are evidence or the presumption great and the court finds based on clear and convincing evidence that the person has threatened another with great bodily harm and that there is a substantial likelihood that the person would carry out the threat if released.

Excessive bail may not be required. In fixing the amount of bail, the court shall take into consideration the seriousness of the offense charged, the previous criminal record of the defendant, and the probability of his or her appearing at the trial or hearing of the case.

A person may be released on his or her own recognizance in the court's discretion.

California Constitution Art 1, §28(e)

(e) Public Safety Bail. A person may be released on bail by sufficient sureties, except for capital crimes when the facts are evidence or the presumption great. Excessive bail may not be required. In setting, reducing or denying bail, the judge or magistrate shall take into consideration the protection of the public, the seriousness of the offense charged. The previous criminal record of the defendant, and the probability of his or her appearing at the trial or hearing of the case. Public safety shall be the primary consideration.

A person may be released on his or her own recognizance in the court's discretion, subject to the same factors considered in setting bail. However, no person charged with the commission of any serious felony shall be released on his or her own recognizance.

Before any person arrested for a serious felony may be released on bail, a hearing may be held before the magistrate or judge, and the prosecuting attorney shall be given notice and reasonable opportunity to be heard on the matter.

When a judge or magistrate grants or denies bail on a person's own recognizance, the reasons for that decision shall be stated in the record and included in the court's minutes.

Bail Increases

If a defendant is arrested without a warrant for a bailable felony offense or for the misdemeanor offense of violating a domestic violence restraining order, and a peace officer has reasonable cause to believe that the amount of bail set forth in the schedule of bail for that offense is insufficient to assure defendant's appearance or to assure the protection of a victim or family member of a victim, of domestic violence, the peace officer shall prepare a declaration under penalty of perjury setting forth the facts and circumstances in support of his or her belief and file it with a magistrate in the county in which the offense is alleged to have been committed or having personal jurisdiction over the defendant requesting an order setting higher bail. The magistrate to whom the application is made is authorized to set bail in an amount that he or she deems sufficient to assure the defendant's appearance or to assure the protection of a victim or family member of a victim of domestic violence, and to set bail on the terms and conditions that he or she, in his or her discretion, deems appropriate, or he or she may authorize the defendant's release on his or her own recognizance. If after the application is made, no order changing the amount of bail is issued within eight hours after booking, the defendant shall be entitled to be released on posting the amount of bail set forth in the applicable bail schedule.

The jail will need a written order to increase the bail either signed by the magistrate or authorized by the magistrate to be signed.

Felony probation – NO BAIL Misdemeanor probation -\$5,000
